What does Jobs for NSW do?

Jobs for NSW is investing a \$190M fund to enable businesses to scale and create new jobs

More than 30% of the fund will be invested outside metropolitan of Sydney, Wollongong, Newcastle:



\$150 million equity fund in partnership with First State Super targeting high potential NSW SMEs

Emerging Fast Growth SMEs

- Growth restricted by available cash
- Bank policy prevents a business loan

- Growth restricted by existing capability
- Bank unwilling to fully fund expansion project

Business expansion:

NSW Funding Roadmap

Building Partnerships Grants

Grants of up to \$100k for startups that are generating revenue to fund a consortium that enables the business to establish key accounts.

Regional Growth Loans

Interest free loans of between \$200k - \$500k for fastgrowth SMEs to create jobs in regional NSW.

Loan Guarantees

Up to 50% of approved project costs to a maximum of **\$5m** to help fast growth SMEs across NSW obtain loan approvals needed to expand and accelerate growth.

Minimum Viable Product Grants

Grants of up to \$25k for pre-revenue startups to progress from proof of concept to MVP stage.

Accelerating Growth Loans

Loans of between **\$200-\$500k** for fast-growth SMEs to create jobs in metro Sydney, Newcastle and Wollongong.

Strategic Growth Loans

Flexible loans of between \$500k and \$1.2m for fast-growth SMEs to create jobs in both regional and metro NSW.



STARTUP CASE STUDY

Binary Beer – North Wollongong



Jobs for NSW helps beer kegs go digital

After receiving a \$25,000 Minimum Viable Product grant from Jobs for NSW, Binary Beer was able to run a trial with local brewing company Five Barrel Brewing Co to gather results from their sensors in a real-world environment.



6 [The grant] allowed us to iron-out problems such as tracking the kegs in cool rooms that are surrounded by metal, which block electromagnetic waves


