#### **HOW TO PLAN:**

It is essential for leaders to develop the skills – and take time – to focus on the organisation's overall direction. The following practical tips will help start the process.

Block out time and commit to planning	<ul><li>One hour a week can suffice</li><li>Protect this time in case operational items get in the way</li></ul>
Use online resources	Check out AMGC's Manufacturing Academy and www.business.gov.au/planning
Access expert advice	<ul> <li>Seek out expertise in areas such as finance and marketing, inclusive of consultants, research institutions or peers</li> </ul>
Apply for a Business Growth Grant	<ul> <li>Explore the Entrepreneurs' Programme for up to \$20,000 in matched funding</li> </ul>
Prioritise planning by including planning steps when developing KPIs	<ul><li>Develop short- and long-term goals</li><li>Focus on more than profit</li></ul>
Consider your entire value chain	Consider your R&D, design, logistics, production, distribution and sales and service
Leverage the Entrepreneurs' Programme	Access business advisors and facilitators who can focus on business evaluation, growth services and supply chain facilitation
Partner with AMGC	AMGC works jointly with industry and research partners to collaborate for greater commercial benefit
